From the Headmasters Desk

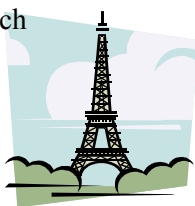
Welcome back after a difficult and icy start to the term. My thanks to all of the staff and teachers at school and nursery who ensured a fantastic level of service to our parents.
