

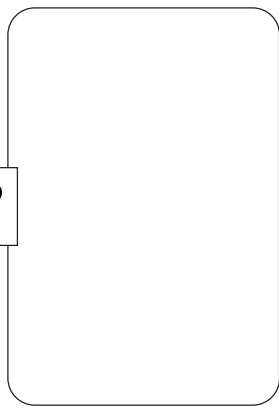
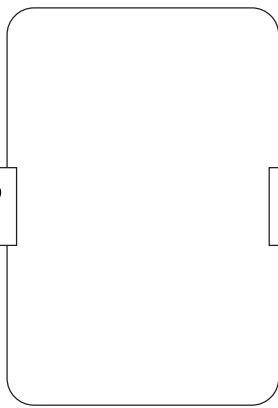
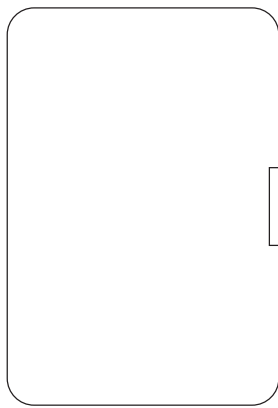
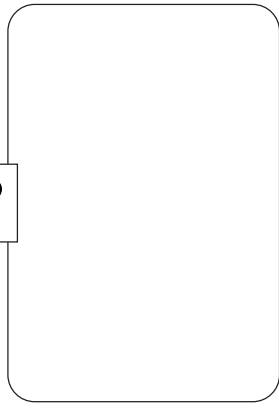
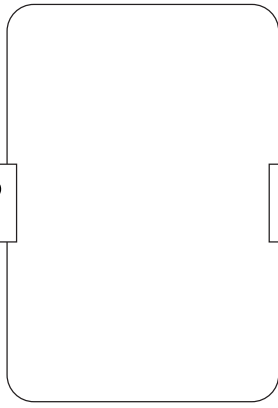
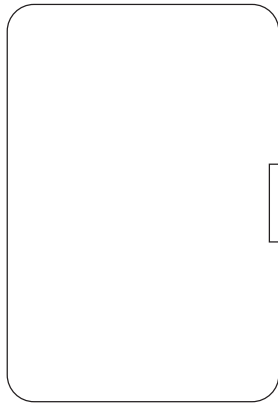
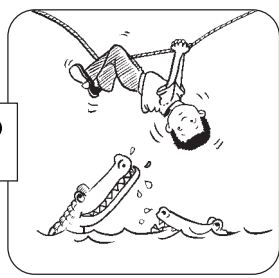
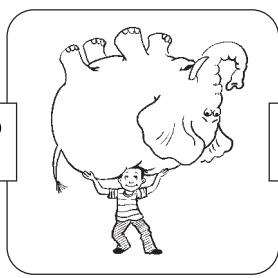
## WOULD YOU RATHER?

### WHAT TO DO

- Ask your child to explain what is happening in each of the pictures.
- Ask them to say which of these activities they would prefer to do, then ask them to explain their choice.
- Ask them to draw pictures of three pleasant choices of their own in the boxes in the second row and three unpleasant choices in the third row.
- Help them to write a short phrase to match each of the nine pictures on a separate piece of paper, eg. 'Swim in treacle.'



Encourage your child to think of more sets of choices (both pleasant and unpleasant), each set more strange or extreme than the last (eg. eating worm pie).
