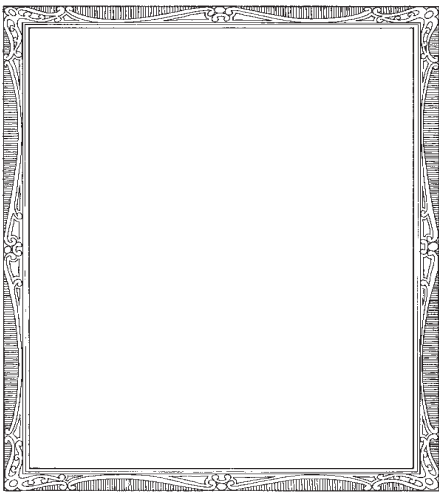


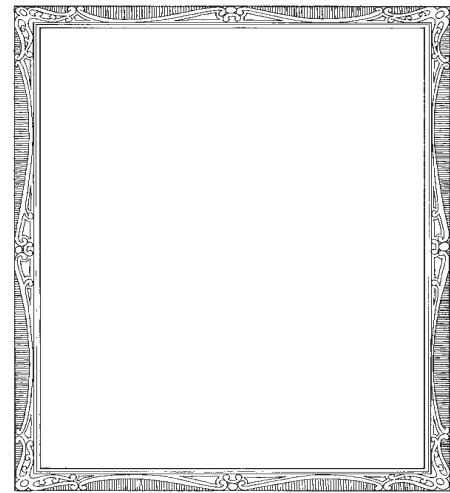

WHAT TO DO

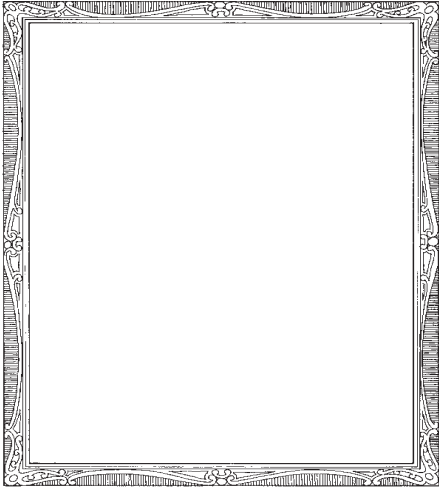
- Find photographs of your child that have been taken at different times of the year and look at them together.

- On the back of this sheet, draw four pictures of a garden or park in each of the four seasons and label them.



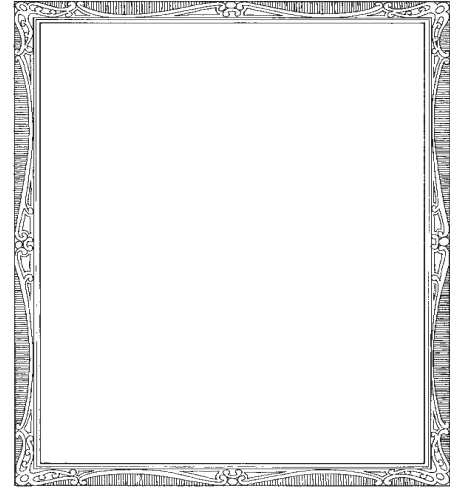
Me in spring
