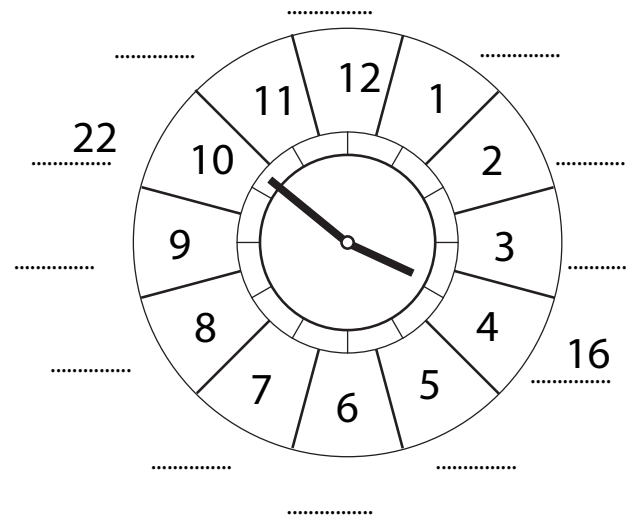


TIME TO GO!
