Over the summer holiday, I am at home from the 26<sup>th</sup> July through until the 22<sup>nd</sup> August if you would like to buy anything, or if you have any items for sale – I can easily meet you, or drop off / collect items from holiday school.

### **Selling uniform via the PTA:**

All items are gratefully received, but in particular I never have enough of the following:

- Tracksuit trousers,
- Boys' V-necked jumpers and swimming trunks,
- Girls' winter skirts and pinafores.

Also I am starting to get requests for preschool-sized items for the new September intake, and am running short of very small sizes. **So if you have a stash of outgrown uniform at home, please consider selling it on through the PTA!**

If you have uniform that you would like to sell or donate to the PTA, then please pass it to reception at school with your details. Please, no more duffle coats.....!

If you are selling items, the PTA takes a commission of 50% - please make this clear by including a note with your name, your child's name and class, and / or your phone number so that I can contact you regarding your payment once the items have sold. If you wish to donate your items 100% to the PTA, again make this clear, and I will price them according to their condition and their saleability, and then all the money raised will be passed directly to the PTA.
